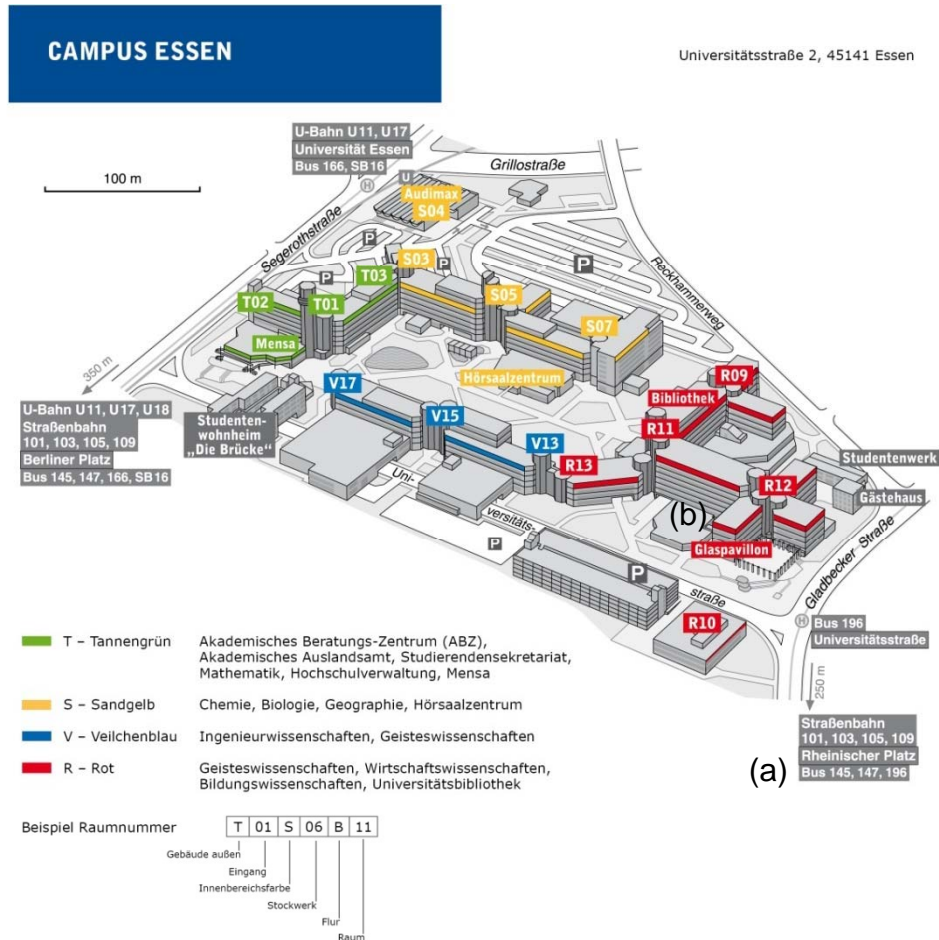
### Why study English in Essen?

# Map to the *Glaspavillon*



From Essen *Hbf* take the streetcar line 101 or 105 to *Rheinischer Platz* (a) and exit towards the university. Enter the red building R12 (passing a fountain and tall red columns). The *Glaspavillon* (b) is located on the ground floor and can be reached by proceeding through the doors on the left-hand side of the lobby.
